This year's fair showcases an extraordinary cross-section of work, from today's most exciting emerging artists to seminal figures of the 20th century. In addition, two new exhibitions explore virtual reality and the significance of self-taught artists, and two new gallery-led sections celebrate contemporary Latinx and Latin American art, and a pioneering New York arts organization.

Frame, Focus & Spotlight

Frame, advised by Andrew Bonacina (The Hepworth) and Laura McLean-Ferris (Swiss Institute), features solo presentations of emerging artists; **Focus** is a platform to support galleries 15 years and younger; and **Spotlight**, curated for the first time by Laura Hoptman (The Drawing Center), presents solo presentations of significant work by overlooked figures and rarely seen practices of modern masters.

New Curated Sections: Diálogos & JAM

In celebration of El Museo del Barrio's 50th anniversary, Patrick Charpenel and Susanna V. Temkin (El Museo del Barrio) present *Diálogos*, showcasing 13 Latinx and Latin American artists, from influential figures to the next generation of cultural leaders.

Franklin Sirmans' (Pérez Art Museum) tribute section pays homage to the pioneering New York arts organization Just Above Midtown (JAM). Founded by Linda Goode Bryant, JAM provided a much-needed platform for African American artists during the 1970s and 1980s.

New Curated Exhibitions

The Doors of Perception is an exhibition of works by visionary self-taught artists from around the world, curated by Javier Téllez and focused on uncharted areas of human consciousness. Presented in collaboration with the Outsider Art Fair.

Electric, curated by Daniel Birnbaum (Acute Art), presents a selection of VR and AR works by artists of different generations who explore these new media from radically different angles. Two programs, "Alternating Current" (AC) and "Direct Current" (DC), will alternate every hour in the stand. *Electric* is realized in partnership with LIFEWTR.

Frieze Artist Award

Curated by Courtney J. Martin (DIA Art Foundation), and supported by Luma Foundation, the recipient of this year's award is Lauren Halsey. Entitled *Prototype Column For Tha Shaw (RIP The Honorable Ermias Nipsey Hussle Asghedom) I & II*, her new commission can be found at the North entrance.

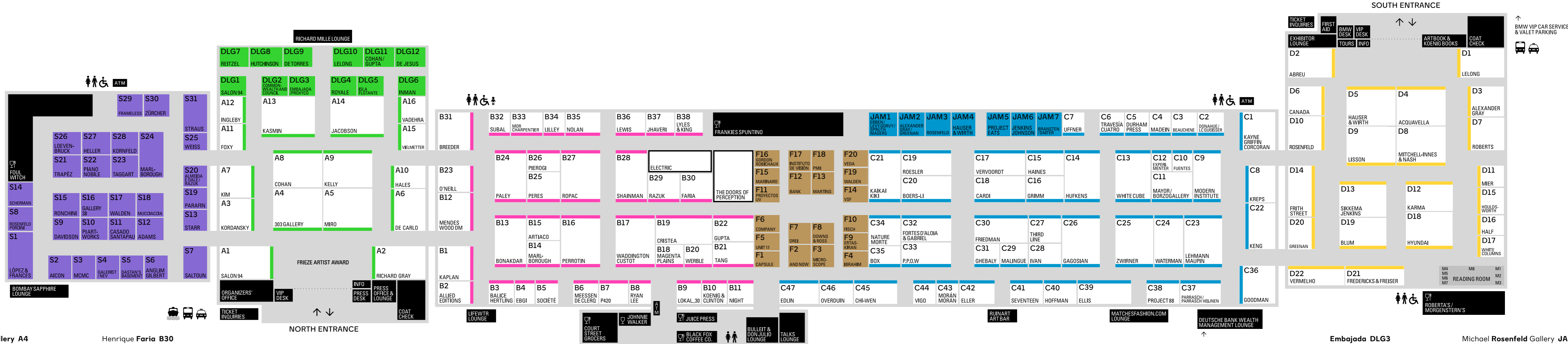
